WAYS FOR YOU TO GET INVOLVED

HANDS-ON SKILL STATIONS

- Set up interactive stations demonstrating skills from different trades.
- Invite potential students and community members to try basic tasks.
- Showcase current students demonstrating competition-level skills.

MINI-COMPETITIONS

- Run small-scale challenges mirroring WorldSkills UK disciplines.
- Award certificates or prizes for top performances.
- Live stream these events on social media to build excitement.





MEET THE EXPERTS

- Invite former competitors and industry professionals to speak.
- Host O&A sessions about careers in different vocational areas.
- Create "day in the life" videos showcasing various trades.

VIRTUAL REALITY DEMONSTRATIONS

- Use VR to showcase work environments like construction sites or creative studios.
- Give students immersive experiences of different vocational settings.
- Connect technologies to real-world skills applications.






By connecting with employers we can spotlight real-world career pathways, strengthen industry partnerships, and create meaningful opportunities for learners.

- Create direct feedback loops between industry and training providers.


MASTERCLASS PARTNERSHIPS

THE TORCH RELAY

LED BY INSPIRING SKILLS AND WELSH GOVERNMENT

A high-profile and symbolic torch relay celebrating vocational skills excellence across Wales — bringing together communities, colleges, training providers, and employers in the lead-up to the WorldSkills UK National Finals.

This is more than a relay—it's a powerful public platform to shine a spotlight on local talent, showcase regional strengths, and demonstrate your organisation's commitment to skills development. With stops across the country, the relay ensures that every corner of Wales has the chance to be part of the national conversation on vocational excellence.

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By getting involved, you could gain valuable media exposure, strengthen communities, and position your organisation as a champion of future skills.

We are open to your ideas on how you can raise your own profile, but here are some of our thoughts:

RELAY ROUTE

- The torch will visit key locations across Wales over a 2-3 week period.
- Each stop could represent a different vocational skill area or industry sector.
- The route will look to showcase Wales' diverse skills landscape.

TORCH BEARERS

- Current WorldSkills UK competitors from Wales.
- Alumni from previous competitions.
- Local employer champions who support vocational education.
- Educational and training providers.

DIGITAL ENGAGEMENT

- Live tracking of the torch journey on social media
- Daily spotlight on different skill areas and local success stories
- Virtual torch participation if required
- Video diary from torch bearers sharing their skills journey

HOSTING CELEBRATION EVENTS

You can use celebration events as a fantastic way to recognise and honour the achievements of your students/employees as Team Wales finalists ahead of the WorldSkills UK National Finals. These events boost morale, help build a sense of pride and community among participants, supporters, and stakeholders, and shine a glowing light on your organisation, which is an invaluable future marketing tool.

PURPOSE OF THE EVENT

- Celebrate the success of finalists and tutors and acknowledge their hard work.
- Offer a formal send-off with well wishes and encouragement.
- Provide a platform for media, photography, and storytelling.
- Help us distribute the Team Wales merchandise (e.g. hoodies) to finalists.

SUGGESTED TIMING

- Ideally held 1–2 weeks before the National Finals.
- Coordinate with training schedules to ensure maximum attendance.

FORMAT IDEAS

- Informal reception or breakfast/lunch gathering.
- Speeches from key figures (e.g. ministers, mentors, past competitors).
- Presentation of Team Wales hoodies and certificates.
- Group and individual photo opportunities.
- Short video interviews or case study recordings with finalists.



COMMUNICATIONS OPPORTUNITIES

- Capture high-quality photos and videos for use across social media, press releases, and internal comms.
- Gather quotes and testimonials from finalists, mentors, and families.
- Use the event to build momentum and public interest ahead of the finals.



Create and deliver quality assured competition activity that meets the standard of the WorldSkills UK local skills competition endorsement framework to provide learners with valuable recognition of their skills.


As part of the process, organisations and learners will receive digital credentials acknowledging the involvement in the programme for use across promotional and marketing material.
