- Promote green growth and jobs as a career pathway;
- Promote the Welsh language, culture, and tourism.

 This event will aim to be showcase skills excellence and be a 'teaser' for the National Finals coming to Wales in November, actively encouraging Members of the Senedd to visit the finals



- Whilst one event it is celebrating two areas welcoming home the EuroSkills competitors who went to Herning and celebrating the Welsh competitor taking part in the WorldSkills UK National finals in November.

# Squad for WorldSkills Shanghai

Following some competitors being withdrawn from the process Team Wales currently have 15 competitors in Squad UK

Training is underway with these 15 individuals with a budget allocated from the ISEiW project to support training for the competition. This is a contribution and it is expected that employers etc also invest in the upskilling of the squad participants.

Unfortunately, since our last update we have lost 2 squad members, one being removed by the UK following an assessment in health and social care but is age eligible for next cycle and will be kept involved and 1 competitor withdrew due to personal reasons in Industrial Electronics.

### 3. Taith funding

During our last meeting we updated you regarding an exchange between Finland and Pembrokeshire College and this is ongoing and there are potential opportunities for other partners in the future and we are now seeing the impact of this with the additional competition in Cleaning Services
