

Al Foundations for Work-Based Learning Providers in Wales

A free, Medr-funded AI training series from Jisc, in partnership with NTfW

Jisc is pleased to offer a new series of free, Medr-funded online training sessions for NTfW members, focused on building practical AI confidence for teaching, training and assessment staff across work-based learning in Wales.

This offer provides access to Jisc's **Al Literacy Curriculum for Teaching and Learning Staff** — a structured, evidence-based introduction to safe, effective and ethical Al use in education.

There are **approximately 40 places remaining**, available on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration is **free** using the code **WALESFREE** (select *non-member* when booking).

What is it?

A structured set of **online Al training modules**, designed specifically for teaching and learning staff in work-based learning and apprenticeship settings. The curriculum has been developed through UK-wide collaboration.

The programme introduces the fundamentals of AI, its practical uses in education, and the knowledge educators need to use AI safely, ethically and confidently.

Sessions include real examples, short activities, and supporting resources that staff can use immediately.

Training Modules included

There **eight** courses available. You do not need to complete whole modules and can just select **individual sessions** which are relevant to you.

Module 1 – Understanding AI in tertiary education for teaching and learning (AI foundations and awareness)

Build a strong foundation by learning core AI concepts and terminology, understanding its role in education, and developing the skill of effective prompting.

Sessions:

- Understand Al basics for teaching and learning
- Exploring Al's role and impact in teaching and learning
- Prompting for teaching and learning staff

Module 2 - Essential AI skills for teaching and learning (Applied AI skills)

Develop practical techniques for using AI in teaching and learning. This module explores how to use AI tools to create teaching content, tailor learning materials, and support day-to-day teaching and learning administration.

Sessions:

- Effective use of AI in teaching and learning
- How Al can improve productivity for teaching and learning

Module 3 – Ethical and responsible use of AI for teaching and learning (Critical evaluation and responsible use)

Learn how to use AI responsibly, with a focus on bias, academic integrity and data protection.

Sessions:

- Recognising AI bias and misinformation for teaching and learning
- How to maintain academic integrity in an Al age FE
- Al privacy and data security for teaching and learning staff
