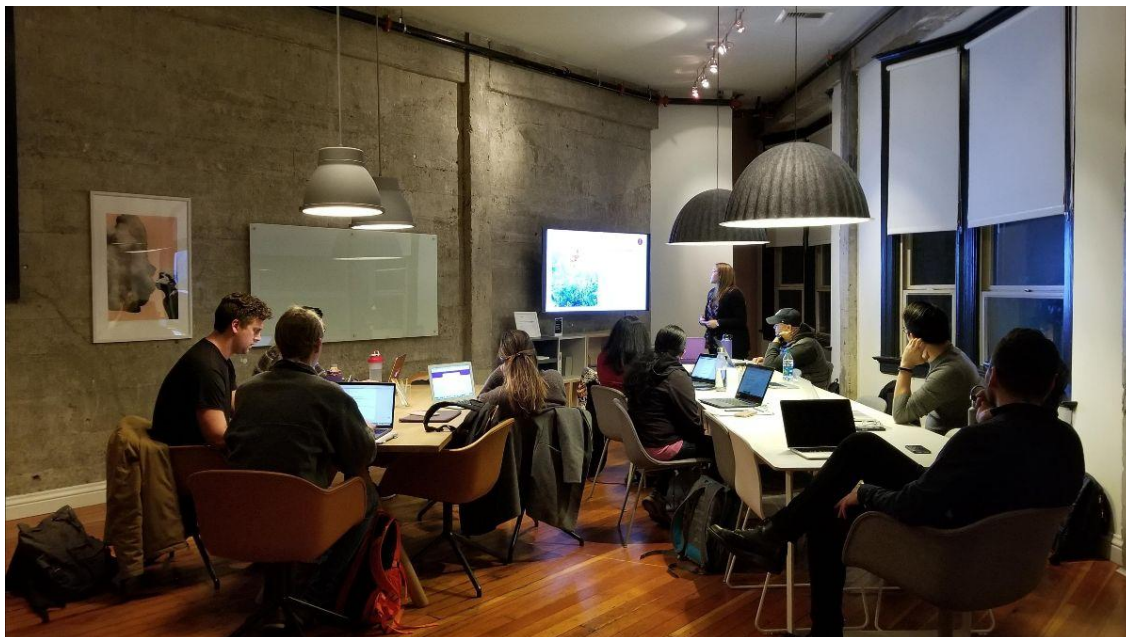

Time is running out to be part of Pathway 2 (Partnership and Strategic Collaboration); a funding opportunity designed for Welsh organisations to lead innovative education projects in collaboration with international partners. These projects tackle key educational priorities in Wales while drawing on global insights to enrich learning and practice at both local and national levels.

We've already supported some inspirational projects such as [Plan International](#) and their visit to explore ways to address gender-based violence, and [Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Glantaf's](#) visit to New Zealand to learn about decolonising the curriculum.

With the Taith programme set to end in 2028, this is your final chance to apply for and deliver a Pathway 2 project. If you have a proposal and would like to discuss it, [please fill out your details here](#) and we'll arrange a meeting.

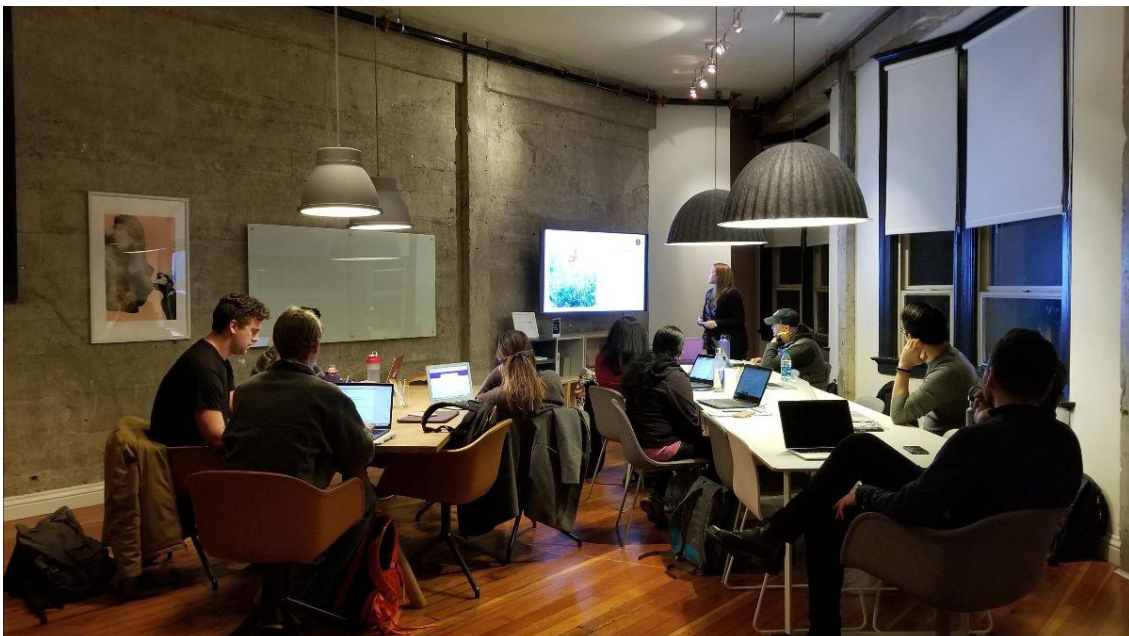
Before You Apply for Pathway 2: What You Need to Do

Before submitting your application, it's important to make sure Pathway 2 is the right fit for both your project idea and your organisation.

Here are the key steps we'd recommend you take:

- Read the [Pathway 2 Guide](#) thoroughly, and make sure that Pathway 2 is the right fit for your organisation and planned project
- Read the [eligibility guidance](#) for organisations and make a note of the information you need to have ready to complete the eligibility form
- Make sure you check you are applying to the correct sector. The different eligibility rules for each sector can be found in section 2.1 of the [Pathway 2 Guide](#)
- Read through the [Pathway 2 application support document](#) – this has all the qualitative questions you will need to answer as part of the application
- Check what other Pathway 2 projects we've previously funded on our [planned projects](#) page

Top Tips for Pathway 2



We've got some great tips to help you with your Pathway 2 application!

1. Check past projects

Make sure your idea is new as we are unlikely to fund same/similar projects already funded. Look at our planned and completed projects

pages before applying.

If unsure, please contact us, we're happy to help!

2. Evidence the need

Show the gap your project will fill in Wales and link it clearly to Taith's strategy and themes.

3. Show impact & share widely

Explain how your outputs will benefit the sector, be shared, and have long-term value.

4. Justify partners & budget

Show why your international partner's knowledge and experience is essential, and ensure every cost is purposeful and linked to outcomes.

Developing Community Focused Schools in Wales: Learning from and with our community partners in Florida

Lead School: Pencoed Primary School
Theme: Developments in Education

Pencoed Primary School partnered with two other schools; Ysgol Y Gogarth and Ysgol Pen Rhos, to apply for Taith Pathway 2 funding to support the development and sustainability of community focused schools in Wales. Their project supports the Welsh Government's ambition for all schools in Wales to become community focused schools. They went to Florida as much of the research on the impact of community schools comes from the United States and there is a well-established community school programme in Florida.
